

Checklist for Summer & Fall 2023 Dual Enrollment Advisement JEFFERSON HIGH SCHOOL

Students and Parents please complete steps 1 and 2 listed below prior to scheduling a Dual Enrollment Advisement conference with the Counselor.

- _____ 1. View the dual enrollment video from the www.readytograduate.com dual enrollment page.
- _____ 2. Apply to your college of choice through the college's dual enrollment website. Submit ACT/SAT/Accuplacer/PSAT scores if applicable. Students complete this through collegeboard.org or act.org website. Your college may have additional forms to return before you can be admitted. Read their website carefully. Missing docs WILL create unnecessary delays.
- _____ 3. Submit your high school transcript via the www.gafutures.org website. Login to your student account. Next, click the *College Planning* tab. Scroll down & click *High School Transcripts*, and complete the request. Make sure your social security number is entered correctly in both Infinite Campus and your student account. This is required for funding.
- _____ 4. Complete and submit the dual enrollment funding application at www.gafutures.org. The application will apply for summer & fall, 2023 and spring 2024. Login to your student account. Click *HOPE & State Aid Programs*. Next, click *State Aid Applications & Forms*. Select *Dual Enrollment Funding Application* and enter your information. Parent MUST complete their portion by deadline.
- _____ 5. Contact Student Services to schedule meeting with your Counselor, whether you are a 1st time DE applicant or a continuing DE student.
- _____ 6. Read & initial parent and student parts of the [JHS Dual Enrollment Contract](#) AND the [JHS Dual Enrollment Advisement Plan](#).
- _____ 7. Return [JHS Dual Enrollment Contract](#) AND the [JHS Dual Enrollment Advisement Plan](#) to Student Services **ON OR BEFORE** April 15th for summer & fall 2023 enrollment.

Dual Enrollment Partner Admissions Criteria

Lanier Technical College:

A minimum 2.6 core GPA is required. If lower, ACT, SAT, Accuplacer or PSAT test scores will be required. 10th Graders may only take technical course work unless they provide a 1200 SAT or a 26 ACT in one test administration.

University of Georgia:

Not applicable for summer term. Fall term application opens March 16th and all supporting documents must be submitted to UGA by May 31st. Open to 11th-12th grade students.

University of North Georgia:

Open to 11th-12th grade. Must have a minimum core GPA of 3.25 and the following test scores: SAT-530 R/W and 480 Math **OR** ACT with 20 in Reading or English and 18 in Math. Accepts PSAT/Pre-ACT.

Young Harris College:

Open to 11th-12th Grade. Must have a minimum core GPA of 3.0. If core GPA is below 3.0, ACT or SAT scores must be submitted for review. Math course placement requires additional review.

****Note:** The college application, high school transcript, Dual Enrollment funding application, JHS contract and advisement plan must be fully submitted on or before the April 15th, 2023 deadline. Male students turning 18 during the semester must complete the Selective Service requirements to receive Dual Enrollment funding.
